

Indoor Services: What to Expect

- To maintain recommended social distancing protocol, there is a limit at 25% of building capacity which amounts to 100 people total (including all lay ministers and clergy who are serving) in the Auditorium.
- **At this time, wearing masks will be required while indoors in accordance with the recent Order from the California Department of Public Health. Plan to bring your own mask if you have one. We will have disposable masks available for those that do not have one.**
- If you are an at-risk person or exhibiting signs of illness, please continue to join us live online for your safety and the safety of others.
- **Children's Ministry will provide activity booklets for the service (and soon, quiet toys to engage them during service.) Children will stay with parents during the service.**
- Service begins at 1:30pm. Please arrive 10-15 minutes early to allow the ushers to seat you in designated open rows.

Here Are Some Ways We Are Keeping You Safe:

- Sanitizing all used spaces between services
- Limiting the number of people in worship spaces at one time.
- Dropping offerings into basket at the altar rather than passing a basket.
- Maintaining 6ft between individuals and families while seated and while interacting inside the building
- Providing disposable masks for those who do not have one
- Providing hand sanitizing stations at entrance
